

Community America Invitational - 5K Course Baldwin City Golf Course – Baldwin City, KS

1. Go south on I-35 to US-56 Gardner exit.
2. Take US-56 to Baldwin City (over 16.5 miles).
3. In Baldwin City, look for a John Deere dealership on your right. Just past this dealership, you will see a road called “Douglas County 14” and a sign pointing to the Midland Railway Depot (this road is also called N250). As you get into town, it turns into High Street.
4. Take High Street to the street just before the Midland Railway Depot.
5. Turn left. At the end of this street is the golf course. You will have to park on the side streets as on site parking is very limited. There are usually athletes from Baldwin High School to assist with parking.

Alternate route:

1. Take highway K-10 west to Eudora.
2. Take the Church Street exit; at the stop sign, make a left so you are heading south (you will be on E2200 Rd).
3. Go south 11 miles and you will come to a stop sign - this will be the only stop sign that you will encounter. Turn right (onto US-56) and go west.
4. Continue west into Baldwin City. Follow directions above from step 3.
